

Night Sky Viewing at the Refuge

Our refuge, the Eastern Shore of Virginia National Wildlife Refuge, is requesting your groups support to interpret the night sky for our visitors. We anticipate receiving a group of 25-40 persons at our refuge for this special evening night viewing. We would like your group to point out some constellations, meteors, and items of interest in the night sky during at least one of the two dates that we specified above. Our refuge does not have any specialized telescopes; so if your group is able to bring those, it would be greatly beneficial for our visitors. Lastly, we have a fully functioning refuge classroom in our visitor center which is capable of holding 42 people; your group is welcome to do a presentation before the event or during the event as well. Our classroom is fully a/v equipped, and has HDMI and USB cords to hook up a laptop and show a presentation view our overhead projector. Should your group require overnight housing, we have a bunkhouse available. We can also supply free passes to get across the Chesapeake Bay Bridge Tunnel as well for 1-2 vehicles.
